Seed Scholars at Yale University in Partnership with Yale Women in Economics Scholar Program

- Household income of one hundred twenty five thousand dollars or less, including combined custodial and non custodial parental income
- GPA of three point zero or higher
- Must attend a public or parochial school
- All genders and backgrounds may apply
- Location served: Nationwide

College Prep Leadership at the Ivy League Scholar Program

- Household income of one hundred twenty five thousand dollars or less, including combined custodial and non custodial parental income
- Household incomes above one hundred twenty five thousand dollars will be required to pay a program fee of one thousand dollars
- Must attend a public or parochial school, open to private/independent school students
- All genders and backgrounds may apply
 - Male self-identifying students/Nonbinary students join EMERGE (Empowering Men to Excel Rise Grow and Elevate) Community within College Prep Leadership
 - Female self-identifying students/Nonbinary join ASCEND (Advancing Sisterhood Confidence Empowerment Network Determination) Community within College Prep Leadership
- Locations served: New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Other states are eligible to apply
